- Nickname—what you want them to call you
- What you hope to learn from your other school partner
- Anything they need to know (you are moody, you run late all the time, you have a job,)
- Camera must be on your face
- No masks please
- Please do your best to eliminate outside noises (within reason)

Remember! You are introducing yourself to someone who lives in another state, goes to another school and has no idea what your life is like and you are going to work together on a project! Assume nothing and try to teach them the very basics about you so they know how to address you

DAY Y: FLIPGRID + STORYBOARD THAT

YOU AND YOUR PARTNER WILL CO-ANNOTATE A MOMENT IN THE STORY AND BEGIN TO NARROW DOWN A MOMENT OF THE STORY THAT YOU WANT TO ILLUSTRATE TOGETHER. PLEASE NOTE, YOU MAY AND SHOULD TALK TO EACH OTHER ABOUT WHAT IS HAPPENING AS YOU ARE SHARING THIS EXPERIENCE TOGETHER -THAT CAN BE PART OF YOUR STORY. SO, YOU MAY BE FOCUSING ON THE FATHER, DRAWING THE FATHER AND SHARING WITH EACH OTHER ABOUT YOUR OWN FATHERS AS PART OF YOUR RESPONSE TO THE STORY.
