Host Families:

- Share their home, heart, and daily lives with their hosted son or daughter.
- Provide a bed and meals (students have their own insurance and spending money).
- Receive on-going support from community-based AFS Volunteers who also work with students to place them in local high schools.
- Are asked to guide, love, and support their hosted student as they would their own children.
